Negligence—Street railway—Pedestrian struck by defendant's tramcar— Judgment, on verdict of jury, against defendant for damages, sustained on appeal.

APPEAL by the defendant from the judgment of the Court of Appeal for Manitoba (1) dismissing the defendant's appeal from the judgment of Curran J., on the verdict of a jury, whereby the plaintiffs recovered damages for the death of their father, caused through his being struck by an electric tramear belonging to the defendant.
